Thanks to VECONAC's activities and efforts, the organization has been recognized by the ASEAN as a humanitarian body who has been carrying out activities directly with the war veterans and their families. ASEAN have is also reviewing the qualification of the Veterans Confederation to include the Veterans Confederation of ASEAN Countries as part of the ASEAN activities.

VECONAC members have always regularly carried out as per the objectives of the Confederations such as exchange of visits by delegates of the member countries to understand and learn about provision of services and encouragement to veterans. Member countries have always mutually cooperated and provided trainings of skills to veterans pursuant to the protocol of understanding between the member countries and mutually provided aid and support directly to veterans of the member countries.

- 6. Creation of VECONAC Office of Economy;
- 7. Conferment of VECONAC Chairmanship Decoration of Honor to Veterans Association of Brunei Armed Forces;
- 8. Increase of annual membership fee;
- 9. Conferment of VECONAC Chairmanship Decoration of Honor and VECONAC Decoration of Honor;
- 10. Conferment of VECONAC Decoration of Honor to the host country;
- 11. Financial report and budget plan;
- 12. Certificate of Admiration for the President, Secretary-General, and Treasurer-General of the host country;
- 13. Praise of the host country;

Last but not least, as the rotating president of the Veterans Confederation of ASEAN Countries, I would like to extend gratitude towards both Samdechs and wish both Samdechs good health, strength, longevity, and wisdom to lead the Cambodia ship towards more growth and prosperity.
