JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ

INTRODUCTION

1. The President and Vice Presidents of Veterans Confederation of ASEAN Countries (VECONAC) met at VECONAC 19th General Assembly (GA) which was convened on 10th December 2019 at Sokha Hotel, Phnom Penh, Kingdom of Cambodia. The 19th GA was attended from all Vice-Presidents and VECONAC member countries. The list of participants is at Annex "A".

32ND Executive Board Meeting

2. The VECONAC 32nd EBM is regularly ever held as stated and endorsed in the constitution and by law. The opening ceremony was honorary opened by H.E General KUN KIM, President VECONAC and held on December 09th 2019 in RaingSab Room, at Sokha Hotel Phnom Penh, Kingdom of Cambodia. The 32nd EBM has endorsed 14 Resolutions were completely approved to be further endorsed in the 19th General Assembly on 10th December 2019. (The 32nd EBM report is at Annex 'B').

OPENING CEREMONY

3. At the VECONAC 19th GA opening ceremony, H.E General KUN KIM Senior Minister, President VECONAC profoundly expressed his thanks to Samdech, Excellencies, national and international distinguished guests, ladies and gentlemen for joining as guests of honor and as members of this important General Assembly of ours at this moment.
