OF THE WORKING COMMITTEE MEETING
October 21, 2020

INTRODUCTION

1. The Working Committee Meeting (WCM) was organized virtually on 21 October 2020 and presided by the Veterans Organizations of Vietnam (VAVN).

ATTENDANCE

2. Ten (10) connection points were available consisting of Vietnam as VECONAC Chair and VECONAC members, namely, Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore and Thailand.

THE WORKING COMMITTEE MEETING

3. The WCM was commenced by the Opening Speech delivered by Lieutenant General (Ret) Nguyen Song Phi, Vice President of VECONAC, Vice President of the VAVN and Chair of the WCM. The Vice President thanked the colleagues for the support of holding the WCM virtually and conveyed the warmest greetings and wish of good health from Senior Lieutenant General (Ret) Nguyen Van Duoc, President of VECONAC and President of the VAVN to the delegates at the connection points. Due to the prolonged and complicated development of the COVID-19 pandemic in the region and the world, the Leadership of the Vietnamese State and Government decided to organize all meetings in 2020 in the form of video conference, including VECONAC meetings, i.e. the WCM, the 33rd Executive Board Meeting (33rd EBM) and the 20th General Assembly (20th GA).
